
Bible Forensics

Rightly Dividing the Depths of Truth July 10, 2022

Today we're looking at Bible Forensics and learning to un-lean on ourselves.









Trust in the Lord with all your heart and <u>lean not on your own</u> <u>understanding</u>; in all <u>your ways</u> acknowledge Him, and He will make <u>your paths</u> straight. – Proverbs 3:5-6 NIV

That's a funny Scripture. Like, funny-ha-ha. Know why? Ever try? Stand up for a second. Now, without touching *anyone* or *anything, lean* on *yourself*. Get it? It's un-doable. Because **leaning means** *resting* on something *stronger*. Ever heard of a "trust fall"? Well it doesn't work out so well on your *own!* But, *take* it from the guy who said:

I said, "I am about to fall," but, Lord, Your love kept me safe. - Psalm 94:18 NCV

Uphold me according to Your Word, that I may live; ... Hold me up, and I shall be safe, and I shall observe Your statutes [Your ways] continually. – Psalm 119:116-117 NKJ

I cried out, "I'm slipping!" and Your unfailing love, O Lord, supported me. When doubts filled my mind, Your comfort gave me renewed hope and cheer. – Psalm 94:18-19 NLT

So learn to lean on your greatest Supporter and Cheer Leader! Cuz you just can't trust *yourself* when it comes to *truth*. Know why? Your *crooked heart!* It's just *waiting* to *stab* you in the *back*.

Thus says the Lord: "Cursed is the man who trusts in man ... whose heart departs from [trusting] the Lord. ... [But] Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, and whose hope is the Lord. ... [So beware, because] The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked; Who can know it? [I'll give you one guess] I, the Lord, search the heart, I test the mind ... to give every man according to his ways – Jeremiah 17:5-10 NKJ

And that's a test we don't want to take! I mean, talk about being out of our depth!

Can you discover the depths of God? – Job 11:7 NAS

Oh, the *depth* of the *riches* of the *wisdom* and *knowledge* of God! How <u>unsearchable</u> His judgments, and His paths <u>beyond tracing out!</u> Who has known the mind of the Lord? [One guess; and it starts with "J"] – Romans 11:33-34 NIV

So, if we can't understand Him, what can we do with Him? Here's a hint: we just went over this.



Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own [back-stabbing] understanding. In all your [crooked] ways acknowledge Him, and He will make straight your paths. – Proverbs 3:5-6 ESV





Remember that *rock* in the *wall*, that wasn't a *rock* at *all*, but a *wrong* way of *thinking*, based on a *lack* of *perceiving*? Do you *see* it for what it is, *now*? You *all* win *that* cigar! The only thing we should trust about the eyes of our heart, is that that **they're blind without pure truth**. And when we *lean* on our *own*, we're *on* our *own*. If we're not gonna trust Him 100%, why *trust* Him at *all*? Cuz if *you* won't trust, *He* can't lead. Not *effectively*. Know why? The blinders on the eyes of your heart. Last Sunday we saw that a "doctrine" is a way of thinking about God; and:

[An] idol is [simply] a worthless doctrine. – Jeremiah 10:8 NKJ

[And the Lord says] [Everyone] who sets up his idols in his heart ... are all estranged from Me by their idols [worthless ways of thinking about Me] — Ezekiel 14:4-5 NKJ

[And] [Everyone] who sets up his idols in his heart, and puts before him what causes him to stumble into iniquity, and then comes to the prophet, [for guidance] I the Lord will answer him who comes, according to the multitude of his idols, – Ezekiel 14:3-5 NKJ

Why?! Because God's perfect Word is *subject to* and *limited by* the warping from our lack of perceiving and worthless ways of thinking, i.e. the doctrine-idols hiding in our heart. So:

Do not listen to the words of the prophets who ... make you worthless; they speak a vision of their own heart, not from the mouth of the Lord. [i.e. Scripture] ... [For] Who has marked His Word and [actually] heard it? ... [If they] had caused My people to hear My Words, then they would have turned them from their evil way ... Indeed they are prophets of the deceit of their own heart ... He who has My Word, let him speak My Word faithfully. – Jeremiah 23:16-28 NKJ



Last Sunday we saw a "rock in the wall" when Legion was pleading with Jesus after He commanded the demon to come out. And I pointed out that something was really wrong with our way of thinking here ... because Legion was pleading with Jesus after He commanded the demon to come out! Which opened our eyes to the more complete story of Jesus obviously previously casting out the "many demons" that had "seized him" (literally: caught him) "many times". (Lk 8:29-30) Well try this one on: because, several times, Jesus clearly says that:

"The Son of Man ... must be killed and ON the third day be raised to life." - Luke 9:22 NIV

Except when He clearly says:

As Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the great fish, so will the Son of Man be three days and three NIGHTS IN the heart of the earth. – Matthew 12:40 NKJ

Now, He's in the tomb *Friday, Saturday,* and *Sunday;* so He's *definitely* "in the heart of the earth" three *days.* But Friday and Saturday *night* only equal *two.* So, *true* or *false?*

Those three nights really foul things up. Oh, did I mention that He also *clearly* says that:

The Son of Man must ... be killed, and AFTER three days rise again. – Mark 8:31











On the fourth day?! Yep. However you count it, that's what comes after three days, about midnight! See my problem? I'm afraid you don't. Cuz that's not my problem. That's perfect. My problem is me. The worthless eyes of my heart that can't see the perfect when it's staring me in the face! But how do you straighten that, let alone weave it together? As you may know, I mean to harmonize the Gospels, and I mean to weave 'em together, by hook or by crook, into One Word. And it's mostly done. Has been for some time – except a few little parts that really foul things up. Like that one! So my whole goal has become to get out of my own way, by un-leaning on my own entrenched assumptions, as learned from the assumptions of others, so that I can finally, hopefully sooner rather than later, stop forcing God's Word to fit my way. Which is way easier said than done! Turns out, it's really tough to get out of our own way, and stop trying to straighten things out on our own. Cuz un-leaning requires so much un-learning, cuz our biggest problem is how He won't say things the way we think He means to. Ever catch yourself doing that? Well, we might as well gag God, if we're going to keep forcing Him to speak through the deceitful filter of our devious back-stabber! Cuz, if we're gonna force our faith to fit our agenda it's gonna fail. How can it not? So, instead of putting my efforts into straightening out the Work of God's hands, I've been putting it into reading and listening very carefully, as warned, and crying out regularly for discernment and wisdom, as encouraged.

Yes, if you cry out for discernment, and lift up your voice for understanding, if you seek [wisdom] as silver, and search for her as for hidden treasures; then you will **[finally]** understand the fear of the Lord, and find the knowledge of God. – Proverbs 2:2-5 NKJ

[Cuz] Who can make straight what He has made crooked? – Ecclesiastes 7:13 NKJ

One guess! We need the Good *Shepherd* to lead us in the *straight* and *narrow*. *Jesus* is "the same *yesterday*, *today*, and *forever*," (Heb 13:8) but *I'm* all *over* the place! God's Word is as solid and unbending as a shepherd's crook. So, how can you straighten it without *changing* it? By changing your perspective – the *way* you *see* it. Cuz there's only *one* angle from which that crook appears *straight*. *But*, and I *quote*: "The general consensus on both sides is that you can't have three literal days and three literal nights" And *therefore*, and I *quote*: "On the basis of divergent, conflicting interpretations there is no correct interpretation of the sign of Jonah." However, and I *quote*:

Do not listen to the words of the prophets who ... make you worthless ... they are prophets of the deceit of their own heart ... He who has My Word, let him speak My Word faithfully. [And I mean to give it my all to do just that!] – Jeremiah 23:16-28 NKJ

Cuz I think that simply means trusting with 100% of your heart, that it's 100% true. I mean:

Does not wisdom call out? ... "All the words of my mouth are just; none of them is crooked or perverse. To the discerning all of them are right; they are faultless [lit. straight] to those who have knowledge ... and those who seek me find me." – Proverbs 8:1-9, 17 NIV

And those who won't don't. Because of that multitude of worthless thoughts cluttering our heart and warping His *Word* and His *way* and His *will*. So we need some Bible forensics, because:

The wicked is *snared* in the work of *his own* hands. – Psalm 9:16 NKJ

[Cuz] All the ways of a man are pure in his own eyes, but the Lord weighs the spirits. [i.e. motives] Commit your works [as crooked as they may be] to the Lord, and your thoughts [as driven and tossed as they may be] will be established. – Proverbs 16:2-3 NKJ

Want to see? I got'a warn you, it's kind'a embarrassingly simple. Cuz you know what actually happened on that third night? No? Well, nobody does. It's another huge mystery. But:

Now behold, two of [the disciples] were traveling that same day to a village called Emmaus ... [And] [Jesus] drew near and went with them ... and He indicated that He would have gone farther. [Which direction: horizontal or vertical?] But they constrained Him, saying ... "It is toward evening, and the day is far spent." [And] ... it came to pass, [being the third night] as He sat at the table with them ... He vanished – Luke 24:13-30

And didn't appear again till about midnight in the upper room. But we know with 100% certainty where He went. Back into the heart of the earth. Know how we *absolutely know?* Cuz He *told us!* And He doesn't *lie.* And He's never *wrong.* And He said "the Son of Man [will] be ... three nights in the heart of the earth." There's two things we all agree we don't know about that third night: 1) Where He was; and 2) Why He said exactly where He'd be. Kind'a embarrassing when you look at it that way. And now, applying a bit of Bible forensics, do you suppose this is when:

The graves <u>were opened</u>; [By whom?] and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised; and coming out of the graves <u>after His resurrection</u>, they went into the holy city and appeared to many. [Think they did all that on their own?] – Matthew 27:52-53 NKJ

[Cuz I know that] He was put to death in the body but made alive by the Spirit, through whom <u>also He went and preached to the spirits in prison who disobeyed long ago</u> ... [like] in the days of Noah while the ark was being built. -1 Peter 3:18-20 NIV

And after He appeared to His disciples, *after midnight*, He led them out so they could watch Him ascend into *heaven*. (Mk 16:19; Lk 24:50-51; Acts 1:9) But then, He was pretty *clear* that:

The Son of Man must ... be killed, and AFTER three days rise AGAIN. - Mark 8:31



See what I mean? Want to see what else is said about this? Me too! So I'm on the hunt! The treasure hunt. Problem is, so often when push comes to shove, we don't trust His Word, cuz we don't believe His Word, cuz we don't know His Word, cuz we don't seek His Word ... at least, to change our perspective. But if and when we begin to seek to know Him, He can't not exceed our crooked expectations. So the next time you're imprisoned below by your own dark doings, cry out and seek to correct your perspective; cuz we could all use some un-crooking, by un-learning, by un-leaning on our own understanding.

Trust me, if you trust in *Him*, and *lean* on *Him*, He'll straighten you out.

Father God, thank You for loving me in spite of my sin; forgive me and cleanse me by the sacrifice of Your Son, my Savior; and free me and lead me by Your Spirit and Word, as I seek to trust and follow Jesus Christ, as the Lord of my life. Amen.
