
## An Easter Carol

The Rise of the Ghosts of Christ April 9, 2023

Today is Easter! And He is risen! He is risen indeed! And not only that, but regarding those set free from death: They have risen! They have risen indeed! And not only that, but we who believe in their heart that He rose from the dead: We will rise! We will rise indeed!







The *ghosts* of the dead *writhe* under the *waters* along with *those* who *live* there *with* them. Sheol [or *Hades*] is *naked* before God and Abaddon [lit. *Destruction*] has *no clothes*. – Job 26:5-6 ISV



You can't tell but ... no clothes ... or bodies. And wow, where to start?! "The ghosts", "under the waters", "along with those who live there with them"? Well: before Jesus! And, well before Jesus, Solomon saw His day, and said:



God shall judge the righteous and the wicked ... [but until then] All go to one place ... all return to dust. ... they go to the dead. – Ecc. 3:20; 9:3 NKJ



To *Sheol* in Hebrew, or *Hades* in Greek, or *also* the *underworld*. "Isn't this a bit morbid for Easter?" This is Easter! Cuz whatever Sheol really was, it symbolized a very real realm where all disembodied spirits were imprisoned ... till Easter! From King Hezekiah who said, when condemned to death for his sin:



"I shall go to the gates of Sheol ... [and] I shall not see YAH" [The Lord's name that's praised by the living ... dead] — Isaiah 38:10-11 NKJ

To righteous King David who confidently said:

If *I* make my *bed* in *Sheol*, behold, You *are* there. [He even says "I will see Your face" (Ps 17:15)] ... If *I* dwell in the *remotest* part of the *sea*, [there's that water] even there Your hand will ... lay hold of me. – Psalm 139:8-10 NAS

[Because, as Jesus said] "The gates of Hades shall not prevail" – Matthew 16:18 NKJ

[Even though] The pains of death surrounded me, and ... Sheol laid hold of me - Psalm 116:3 NKJ

[For] neither *death* nor *life* ... nor *height* nor *depth* ... shall be able to *separate* us from the *love* of *God* which is in *Christ Jesus* our *Lord*. – Romans 8:38-39 NKJ

[So] Ask for a sign ... from the depths of Sheol to the heights of heaven. – Isaiah 7:11 HCS



Yet no sign will be given [Jesus warned] ... but the sign of Jonah ... for just as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the sea monster, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. — Matthew 12:39-40 NAS



How does Jesus check out of the Hades hotel on the third morning, but is back in the heart of Hades the third night? He goes back! Kind of a no-brainer. Cuz He vanishes the third night till midnight. But let's look at the sign of Jonah! Because:

[Jonah said] "Out of the <u>belly of Sheol</u> I cried ... for You cast me into the <u>deep</u>, into the <u>heart</u> of the <u>seas</u>, and the <u>floods</u> surrounded me [See the sign?] – Jonah 2:2-3 NKJ

**Jonah's watery grave became the** *universal symbol* used by the *prophetic poets* in Scripture **to** *picture* **Sheol.** So, it *unlocks* and *allows* us to *see* all **the** *Psalms* **of the** *ghosts* **of** *Easter past* – who say:

[Let not] the *deep* <u>swallow</u> <u>me</u> <u>up</u>; and let not the pit <u>shut</u> <u>its</u> <u>mouth on</u> <u>me</u>. ... Draw <u>near</u> to <u>my</u> soul, and <u>redeem</u> it ... set <u>me</u> up on <u>high</u>. ... [For the Lord] does not despise His <u>prisoners</u>. ... [So] [Let] the <u>seas</u> and <u>everything</u> that <u>moves</u> in them [praise Him]. – Psalm 69:15-34 NKJ

I am counted with those who go down to the pit ... adrift among the dead ... in the lowest pit [Lowest? Lowest!] ... in the depths. ... and I cannot get out ... Will You work wonders for the dead? [He will indeed!] Shall the dead arise and praise You? [They shall indeed!] Shall Your lovingkindness be declared in the grave? [It shall indeed!] Or Your faithfulness in the place of destruction? [Hold up. That's the word: Abaddon] — Psalm 88 NKJ

And the answer is: YES! Because they had the Lord's promise of a 'rescue at sea', if you will.



"I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death. [So those who waited for YAH to show up in Sheol, prayed and watched for the day He'd appear and say] O Death, I will be your plagues! O Grave, I will be your destruction!" – Hosea 13:14 NKJ



Cuz they didn't go to the lowest pit. Lowest? Lowest! One place. Two floors. A basement banquet hall for friends. A boiler room below for foes. Remember when wicked King Saul got a witch to bring up the ghost of righteous Samuel? No? Okay!

She cried out at the top of her voice [cuz until the Lord allowed it, like Whoopi in the movie "Ghost", she'd never actually seen a real one] ... [She] said, "I see a ghostly figure coming up out of the earth." ... [and righteous] Samuel said to [wicked King] Saul ... [The Lord has] become your enemy ... [and] tomorrow you ... will be with me." – 1 Samuel 28:12-19 NIV

The righteous with the wicked? For a while. In Jesus' parable of "The Rich Man and Lazarus", He describes a paradise up above, and a painfulness below – where they'd rather be served than saved.



[Lazarus] *died*, and was <u>carried</u> by the angels to *Abraham's bosom*. The <u>[wicked]</u> rich man also *died* and was <u>buried</u> ... in torments in Hades, [but] he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham ... [and said] 'Send Lazarus ... [to] cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.' – Luke 16:22-25 NKJ

Those are flames of wrath against wickedness; cuz, before He died on the cross, the Lord did say:



"A fire is kindled in My anger, and burns to the *lowest part* of Sheol [Lowest? Lowest!] ... and sets on fire the <u>foundations of the mountains</u>." – Deuteronomy 32:22 NAS



[And Jonah said] "I sank to the <u>foundations of the mountains</u>, the earth's gates shut behind me <u>forever!</u> Then You <u>raised</u> my <u>life</u> from the <u>Pit"</u> [and then from the <u>fish</u>] – Jonah 2:5-6 CSB



[And just before] Jesus cried with a loud voice, and gave up the ghost. — Mark 15:37 KJV

[The criminal] [on the cross next to Him, repented and] said, "Jesus, remember me when You come into <u>Your kingdom</u>." Jesus answered him, "I tell you the truth, [let's not get ahead of ourselves] <u>today you will be with Me in paradise</u>." – Luke 23:42-43 NIV

Cuz that's STEP ONE. Cuz two days later, when Jesus rose [as in "up"] on Easter morning:

Jesus said to [an understandably *clingy*] [Mary Magdalene], "Do not cling to Me, for <u>I have</u> <u>not yet ascended</u> to My Father" – John 20:17 NKJ

So where'd He been? Not up in heaven with the Father; but down in paradise with the criminal! And prior to all of this, just before He brought Martha's real-life brother Lazarus back to life:



Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise again." Martha said to Him, "I know [from OT Scripture] that he will rise again in the resurrection at the last day." Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection [at the last day] and the life. [That's Me!] He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die." – John 11:23-26 NKJ



Starting when *He rose!* Not a lot of talk in the OT about the resurrection of the dead. But *Hosea* and *Isaiah* get *specific* about God *raising up* the *souls* of *Sheol*. So, we *know* what *Martha's* referring to.

[Hosea says] Come, let us return to the Lord. For ... He will heal us ... He will revive us after two days; [and] He will raise us up [from Sheol] on the third [and last] day, that we may live before Him. [In heaven] ... His appearance is as sure as the dawn [on day three!] — Hosea 6:1-3 NAS

[And Isaiah says] He was *pierced* for our *transgressions* ... and by *His wounds* we are *healed*. [And therefore and thereby raised up on the *third* and *last day!*] — Isaiah 53:5 NIV

For the Lord himself will come *down* from *heaven*, with a loud command ... and the dead in Christ will rise *first*. [On the *third* – and *last* – day] – 1 Thessalonians 4:16 NIV

For [even] David did not ascend to heaven [apart from Christ] – Acts 2:34 NIV

[Jesus said] "I have *come down* from *heaven* ... And this is the will of Him who sent Me ... [to] lose *none* of *all* that He has *given* Me, but *raise* them *up* at the *last day*." – John 6:38-39 NIV

[Because] "I am the way, the truth, and the life. [And] No one comes to the Father except through Me." [Not even those who died before Me] – John 14:6 NKJ

[So] Blessed are the [naked] dead who die in the Lord from now on – Revelation 14:13 NKJ



For if we live, we live to the Lord; and if we die, we die to the Lord. Therefore, whether we live or die, we are the Lord's. For to this end Christ died and rose and lived again, that He might be Lord of both the dead and the living. – Romans 14:8-9 NKJ



[Christ died] to bring you to God. ... [And] also He went and preached to the [disembodied] spirits in prison who disobeyed long ago – 1 Peter 3:18-20 NIV

All those who go down to the dust shall bow before Him – Psalm 22:29 NKJ



"For a time is coming [Jesus said] when *all* who are in their graves will hear [the Son of Man's] voice [cuz He went and *preached* to 'em] and come out— those [*ghosts* of Easter *present*] who have done good will rise to live," ["before Him"] – John 5:28-29 NIV

[Because] [The Lord] brings down to Sheol and raises up. [to heaven] – 1 Samuel 2:6 NAS

[And David said] "You will not leave my soul in Sheol" — Psalm 16:10 NKJ

You have [already] delivered my soul from the [lowest] depths of Sheol. – Psalm 86:13 NKJ

[And] God will redeem my soul from the power of Sheol – Psalm 49:15 NAS

[But] Who can escape the power of Sheol? – Psalm 89:48 NRS

[Jesus Christ] the firstborn from the dead ... [who] washed us from our sins in His own blood – Revelation 1:5 NKJ

The prophets and Moses said ... He would be the first to rise from the dead – Acts 26:22-23 NKJ

And, speaking of the ghosts of Easter future: on the Mount of Transfiguration:

Moses and Elijah, *appeared* ... *talking* with Jesus. <u>They spoke about His *departure*</u>, which He was *about* to *bring* to *fulfillment* at Jerusalem. – Luke 9:30-31 NIV



His *departure?* Why's He talking to *them* about it? Because:

Behold, [Daniel foresaw] One like the Son of Man, coming [to a heavenly throne] with the clouds of heaven! ... and they [the clouds of heaven] brought Him near before [the Ancient of Days]. Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom – Daniel 7:13-14 NKJ

Cuz that's STEP TWO! Remember when His disciples watched Him ascend into heaven that night?

He was taken up [carried up (Lk 24:51)] before their very eyes, and a cloud hid Him – Acts 1:9 NIV

[Cuz, Isaiah said] They all gather together, [and] they come to You ... because the abundance of the sea shall be turned to You ... [and] They shall ascend with acceptance ... "Who are these who fly like a cloud?" – Isaiah 60:4-8 NKJ

It's our "great cloud of witnesses!" (Heb 12:1) But they're not ghosts! They're restored corpses! Which is why it was so significant to bring them, singing an Easter carol, out of their tombs.

Behold ... The *tombs* were opened, and many [undead] <u>bodies</u> of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised; and coming out of the *tombs* after *His* resurrection *they* entered the holy city and appeared to many. – Matthew 27:51-53 NAS

Awake, awake ... <u>clothe yourself</u> with <u>strength</u>. Put on your <u>garments of splendor</u> ... <u>Shake</u> off your <u>dust</u>; <u>rise up</u> ... <u>free yourself from the chains – Isaiah 52:1-2 NIV</u>

[Because] The Longing soul ... in the shadow of death, bound in affliction and irons ... [He brought] out of darkness ... and broke their chains in pieces. — Psalm 107:10, 14 NKJ

I waited patiently for the Lord; and He ... brought me *up* out of a horrible pit, out of the miry clay ... He has put a new song [of Easter] in my mouth—*many* will *see* it [when those tombs open] and *fear*, *and* will *trust* in the *Lord*. – Psalm 40:1-3 NKJ

## "You're a q-q-q-qhost!" "Nope! I'm a restored corpse! Happy Easter! Read your Bible:"

The [wicked] dead don't live; [cuz] ghosts don't rise. ... we writhed, but ... [we] achieved no victories [also translated: salvation or deliverance] ... [But] Your dead will live, their corpses will rise, [fully restored] and those who dwell in the dust will shout for joy. [Because] Your shadow is a shadow of light, [Picture that shadow in the valley of the shadow of death!] but You will bring down the ghosts into the underworld. [Because Proverbs 21:16 says, "A man who wanders from the way ... will remain in the assembly of the dead." So] Go, my people, enter your rooms and shut your doors behind you ... [for] a little while – Isaiah 26:14-20 CEB

[And] Then, the same day at evening ... when the doors were shut where the disciples were ... Jesus came [back] and stood [quietly] in the midst – John 20:19 NKJ



[Jesus] stood [unnoticed] among them and [not not-having fun] said to them, "Peace be with you." [Also translated: Boo!] They were startled and frightened, thinking they saw a ghost. [But] He said to them ... "Touch Me and see; a ghost does not have flesh and bones ... This is what is written: [in Hosea and Isaiah] The Christ will suffer and rise from the dead on the third [and last] day – Luke 24:36-46 NIV

"Oh that You would hide me in Sheol [says Job] ... until Your wrath returns to You, [on the cross] that You would set a limit for me and remember me!" – Job 14:13 NAS

[One of his so-called *comforters* says] "Can you discover the *limits* of the Almighty? They are high as the heavens ... [and] deeper than Sheol, what can you know?" – Job 11:7-8 NAS

[And Job says] "I know that my Redeemer lives, and He shall stand at last on the earth; and after my skin is destroyed, this I know, that in my flesh I shall see God – Job 19:25-27 NKJ

[You see] Christ died for our sins [Paul later writes] ... [and] rose again the third day according to the Scriptures [in *Hosea* and *Isaiah*] ... But if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ is not *risen*. [Cuz Daniel (7:13-14) says that's who carries Him to the throne! So] ... If the dead do not rise, then Christ is not risen. – 1 Corinthians 15:3-4, 12-19 NKJ

## And they had to rise, cuz there's something vital that the unrisen, disembodied dead can't do:

The dead do *not* hallelu [praise] YAH, nor do any who go down into silence. But we [who ascend] will bless YAH from this time forth and forevermore. – Psalm 115:17-18 ESV

<sup>5:13</sup> And [John saw] every creature which is *in heaven* and *on* the *earth* and *under* the *earth* and *such* as are *in* the *sea* <sup>7:9</sup> *before* the throne and *before* the Lamb, <u>clothed</u> ... [and] <sup>7:10</sup> crying out with a loud voice ... <sup>14:2</sup> like the voice of many *waters* ... <sup>14:4</sup> being *firstfruits* to *God* and to the *Lamb* ["of *God* who *takes* away *sin*" (Jn 1:29)] ... <sup>19:1</sup> saying, "hallelu YAH!" – Revelation 5:13; 7:9-10; 14:2, 4; 19:1 NKJ

Because, He is risen! He is risen indeed! And they have risen! They have risen indeed! And we (who declare with our mouth what we believe in our heart) will rise! We will rise indeed!



## So, don't be caught dead in your sin!

Live as children of light ... This is why it is said: "Wake up, O sleeper, rise from the dead, and Christ will shine [that shadow of light] on you." – Ephesians 5:8, 14 NIV
